As part of our commitment to the health and well-being of our Skate Heroes, Operational Staff, Students, Enthusiasts & Skating Community; we are carefully monitoring the situation and are in regular contact with health agencies for information and guidance. We continue to implement preventive measures in line with their recommendations and the input of our teams.



The San Diego Ice Arena remains open and is currently in operation.

SDIA's protocol is that we clean and maintain our facility daily to help preserve a healthy and safe environment for all our patrons. In addition, the following protocols are being implemented:

Students and Skating Enthusiasts:

We respectfully ask all our skating fraternity to please respect their health, and if you feel in any way impaired, please stay at home. During this period, management will make every endeavor to ensure all missed classes or events will be made up, credited for later use, or reimbursed.

Stay Healthy. This sport is a great way to stay fit and prevent any illness.

1. **Wash your hands often** with soap and water (the CDC recommends washing for at least 20 seconds).
2. Follow proper respiratory cough etiquette.
3. **Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth** with unwashed hands.
4. We ask all our coaching staff to monitor their students and encourage any student considered to be at risk to avoid further participation until deemed safe.
5. Our Skate Heroes monitor our skating public and will encourage patrons to remove themselves from sessions.
6. Our first aid section is equipped with a temperature thermometer. Anyone with an unusually high temperature will be asked to vacate any public or common area and encouraged to call their primary-care physician.

Please respect our team; they are looking after you and the wider community.

Skate Heroes & Operational Staff:

As a facility, we are going to be taking extra precautions to make sure we keep everyone healthy.

1. **Hand Washing** Our team will go the extra STEP by doing the following: upon entering and exiting the ice arena, the team will wash hands with soap and water.
2. **Illness** The team is encouraged to not attend work if experiencing any possible related symptoms such as fever, cough, body aches, shortness of breath, sore throat, etc. If anyone has been recently hospitalized with respiratory illness, traveled internationally within that last 30 days to a high-risk area, or been around anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 30 days, he or she will be asked not to attend work.
3. **Additional Infection Prevention Measures** The staff of SDIA will do enhanced cleaning of "touch-point" areas such as doorknobs, countertops, light switches, handrails, etc. There are Clorox bleach wipes located in the office, on the skate counter, and in the operations room. Any areas that are being touched will be consistently wiped down.
